 - Maintain necessary files and reports relevant to company owned and leased properties
 - Oversee contract formulation and interpretation for land acquisition
- Establish and maintain positive relations with all stakeholders, including managing participant involvement and public consultation programs
- Be the 'go-to' person within Canadian Natural for all land related issues within the designated area such as: access, relationships with land owners, and surface challenges
- Develop positive working relationships with Aboriginal communities local to Canadian Natural's operations
- Work with Geophysical Operations supervisor on community consultation and government permits
- Keep up to date on policies, regulations and laws relevant to land acquisition in Western Canada

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Valid Alberta Land Agent and Commissioner for Oaths License considered an asset but not required
